Proposed resolution on bamboo control:

The Environmental Commission hereby recommends the following actions to the Borough Council:

- 1. That the Borough take appropriate measures to remove bamboo from public lands on the south side of Homestead Lane in the vicinity of the properties at #27 and #29 Homestead Lane.**
- 2. That the Borough Council enact an ordinance prohibiting the planting, growing or maintenance of bamboo on any property unless procedures are established and followed by the person(s) owning, renting or otherwise controlling the property to ensure that said bamboo does not encroach upon or spread to any adjoining property, whether publicly or privately-owned.**
